Objective

The project aims at capacity building (i.e., lifelong learning) in three main areas of e-government services (interoperability, security, and legal informatics), which are the main challenges when implementing e-services in general and e-government in particular .

Training

One of the most important goals for the academy is to provide training and knowledge materials to the Palestinian society, through providing public and private sectors and individuals with a greater understanding of how to implement and deploy an e-government framework, focusing on the interoperability, security, and legal needs. It aims through training to fulfill the needs of the national plans of Palestine and to implement IT based solutions in e-government and integrated services.
