The Arabic Ontology is a documentation of the philosophical capacity of what the Arabic language can express. It can find relationships between the meanings of Arabic words in a natively Arabic way for the first time.

This is the first search engine of its type for a single language. The search engine offers results from 150 Arabic dictionaries.

The ontology is an Arabic-language successor to a project called WordNet, started in 1985 at Princeton University. But while in WordNet a word's meaning is defined according to a consensus of its usage by native speakers, the meanings of Arabic words in Jarrar's system are fixed according to their usage by specialists.

The Arabic Ontology offers the prospect of more precise results from Google searches in Arabic, better online translation of Arabic text, and new insights into the language for students and scholars of Arabic literature.
